018/22 <u>District and County Councillors' Reports</u>

County Councillor

Cllr. Taylor reported as follows:

NCC has been given the green light to progress a devolution deal. It now has to be decided what the bid will look like. For example, it might take the form of a county based, sub-regional or regional deal and possibly an elected Mayor. There is likely to be some public consultation with an announcement in autumn.

There is a lot of regeneration in the county, particularly in the south of the county such as the Freeport at East Midlands airport. There is also potential for West Burton with the possibility of a fusion reactor in the long term.

The NCC budget setting meeting is to take place next week. The proposal is to increase the council tax by 4% this being 1% on the base and 3% ringfenced for adult social care.

3. New Lawn Mower for Cemetery

Cllr. Roberts presented his findings after researching several makes and models of lawn mower. After some discussion it was <u>resolved</u> to purchase a Cobra with a Honda engine at a price of £475 incl. vat. Cllr. Roberts to make arrangements to purchase the mower as soon as possible.

4. Maintenance of the Flood Alleviation Scheme (FAS)

Ian Davies, BDC Drainage Engineer had forwarded a report confirming that the open watercourse between North Moor Road and South Moor Road has been cleared and graded back to original invert and full capacity. Also, the overflow and box culvert on North Moor Road has been cleared and is fully functional. He is continuing his discussions with the Internal Drainage Board regarding future maintenance.
