Parish/Town Council Elections – 4th May 2023

I enclose two copies of the Notice of Uncontested Election and would be grateful if you could arrange for these to be posted as follows:

- a) At the offices of the Parish/Town Council; and
- b) In other conspicuous places within the Parish area (Parish/Town Council notice boards, local post office/shop etc).

Please feel free to copy the Notice and post in additional locations within the Parish, if deemed appropriate.

Legislation says that the membership of the parish council shall retire on the “fourth day after the ordinary day of election” and that the “newly elected councillors shall come into office on the day that their predecessors retire”. Due to the bank holiday, existing councillors retire on Tuesday, 9th May 2023 and new councillors come into office on the same date. All councillors must sign a Declaration of Acceptance of Office before or at the first meeting of the parish council. They must not act as a councillor until they have made the declaration. Failure to make the declaration within the appointed time means that the office will become vacant.

Provided that there is a quorum, the parish council “may co-opt any person or persons to fill any vacancies remaining unfilled”. The parish council has 35 days (excluding dies non) to co-opt, beginning with the day on which the election was to have been held (4th May), before the principal council can exercise any of its discretionary powers under Section 39(4) RPA 1983.

Councillors are also required to register interests as specified in your council’s code of conduct and the relevant regulations. The Monitoring Officer should receive completed forms within 28 days of coming into office, i.e. by Tuesday, 6th June 2023.

The Monitoring Officer will send you a sample declaration of acceptance of office form and a sample registerable interests form in due course.

Your co-operation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
